600 WSJS AND 680 WPTF ARE THE NEW RADIO HOMES FOR NASCAR IN THE TRIAD AND TRIANGLE

RALEIGH, NC (February 4, 2011) NewsRadio 680 WPTF and 600 WSJS, The Triad's NewsRadio, have announced they are now "NASCAR Radio" for the Triangle (Raleigh-Durham-Chapel Hill) and Triad (Greensboro-Winston Salem-High Point) respectively. Effective with the 53rd Daytona 500 on Sunday, February 20th, the stations will broadcast the entire season of Sprint Cup Racing on their expansive AM signals. As North Carolina's newest affiliates for both the Motor Racing and Performance Racing Networks, the stations will carry all Sprint Cup races plus the popular NASCAR "LIVE" call-in program Tuesday nights at 7:00PM.
