NewsRadio 680 WPTF serves the Raleigh-Durham-Chapel Hill Market, AM 600 WSJS is the news and talk voice of Greensboro-Winston Salem-High Point, and FM Talk 101.1 WZTK serves both the Triad and the Triangle markets from its Burlington, N.C. base.
